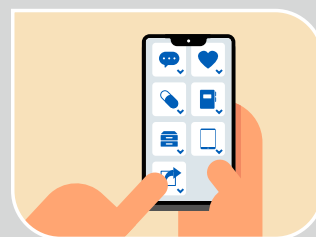
# Key details of your child's care. All in one place.

The Care Information Exchange can give you, and your child, secure online access to their hospital health records.

## When can you and your child get access to records?

- Under 13 year olds      Parents can have access on behalf of their children.
- 13 to 15 year olds      Parents can have access if the young person gives consent. The young person can also have access themselves.
- 16 and over      The young person now has control over their record. They can give access to their parents if they choose to.

Parents can continue to have access on behalf of their child until the age of 17 for young people with learning disabilities.
